<p>Estimated results</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Environmental improvement in Falesti district (Md) and Iasi district (Ro) and neighboring region; • new collection platforms; • Increased volume of recycled waste through separate collection of PET bottles, glass, paper and the waste separation line; • Reduction of volumes of solid municipal waste, eliminated through storage, including biodegradable waste; • Reduction, at the municipal landfill, of toxic emissions, including greenhouse gas emissions, generated by the degradation of organic waste through anaerobic decomposition; • Improvement of technical capacities of the existing landfills in Falesti town (Md) and Tirgu Frumos village (Ro) through the installation of a waste separation line; • Increase of public awareness on the impact caused by an inadequate solid municipal waste storage, including sustainable use of secondary raw materials as glass, paper, PET bottles Falesti district (Md), Iasi district (Ro) and Cernovitscaia Oblast (Ua).
